OVERVIEW

Runners have been participating in this cold winter day run in Jacksonville Beach since 1976. The Winter Beach Run takes place every year towards the end of January. Runners line up at the Seawalk Pavilion to head out for the 10-mile, five-mile or new in 2017, the one mile fun run. Participants receive a custom-designed moisture wicking shirt and a special crafted finishing medal once they complete the race. About 1,200 runners are expected to participate. The Winter Beach Run helps fund high school cross country and track teams and benefits the Jacksonville Track Club.
